The proposal should approximately be 3-pages in length.

A successful application should include the following:

- Well-developed hypothesis: The hypothesis is testable and presented in clear language.
- Detailed statistical plan: Statistical methods are well-designed and comprehensive.
- Strong mentorship: There is clear demonstration of mentorship to support the project.
- Feasible primary outcomes: Each aim is achievable, focused, and logical.
- Innovation: Project concept is original, novel, and will advance the applicant's long-term career goals.
- Well-defined training plan and integration of clinical and research activities, i.e., a clear plan for career development.
- Evidence of an effort to support principles of equity, diversity, and inclusion.

Q25 The postdoctoral candidate and both supervisors are required to provide NIH-type Biographical Sketches. If relevant, at the end of each Biosketch (in one-half page or less) postdoctoral candidates may describe any career interruptions (with relevant dates) or extenuating factors that have impacted their research or clinical training. If the postdoctoral candidate's PhD was completed more than 3 years ago, or professional health degree completed more than 10 years ago, please explain why further training via the WIN clinical/research postdoctoral fellowships will be valuable. Q31 Applicants must submit 2 letters of reference (1 page each preferred) supporting the postdoctoral candidate's potential for a clinical, academic research career and qualifications for the scholarship.

The first letter must be a joint letter from the two proposed supervisors (clinical and basic). The letter should specifically indicate:

- How the proposed research fits into the mentors' research and clinical programs
- Expertise and experience in the area of research proposed and the nature of the mentors' proposed time commitment to the supervision and training of the applicant
- Mentors' prior experience in the supervision, training, and successful mentoring of clinician scientists
- Potential for applicant's future research career and comparison of applicant amongst others the mentors have trained.
- Provide confirmation of matched funding from the candidate's home department or other funding source.

The second letter must be from a prior supervisor (clinical or research) supporting the postdoctoral candidate's potential for a clinical and/or academic research career and qualifications for the fellowship. Letters must be saved as pdfs and uploaded below.
